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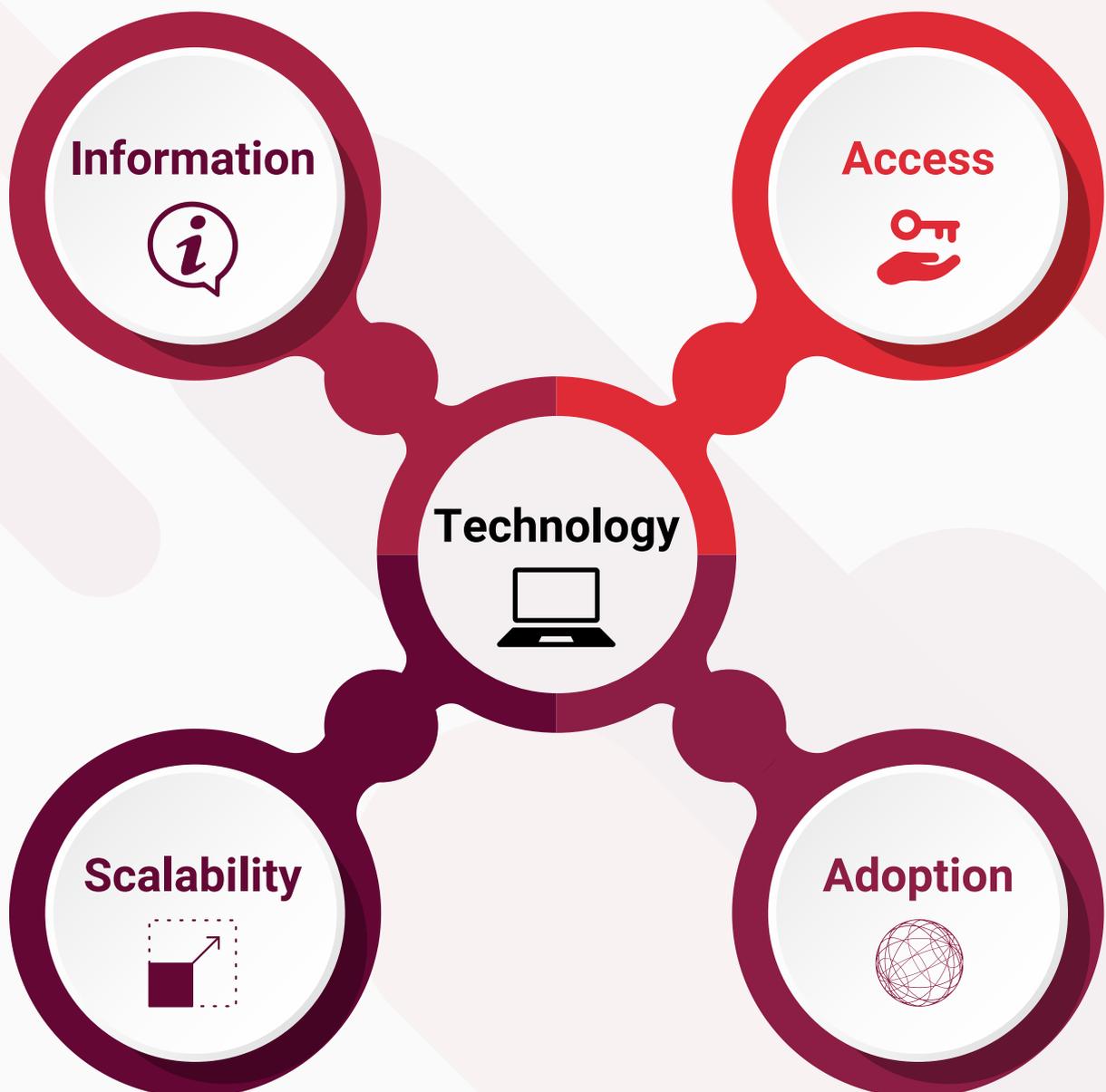
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# Introduction

The HR Transformation Survey was designed to uncover trends across payroll and human capital management (HCM) tech that influence work, employee experience and business outcomes.

The survey was conducted from October 2023 to January 2024 and had responses from 50 organisations across Australia and New Zealand.

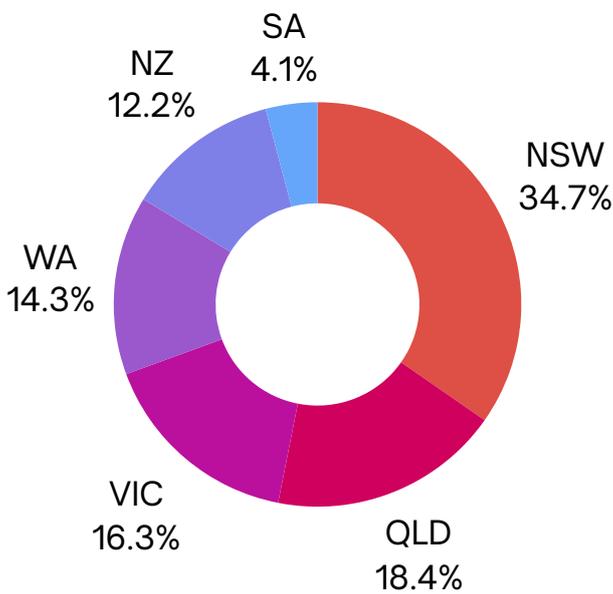
The graphic below outlines the key framework that we've used to organise the results of the survey:



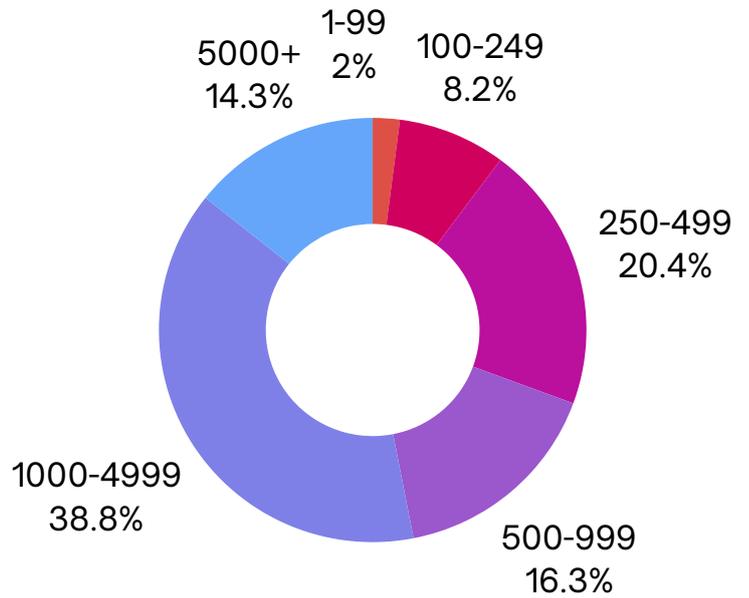

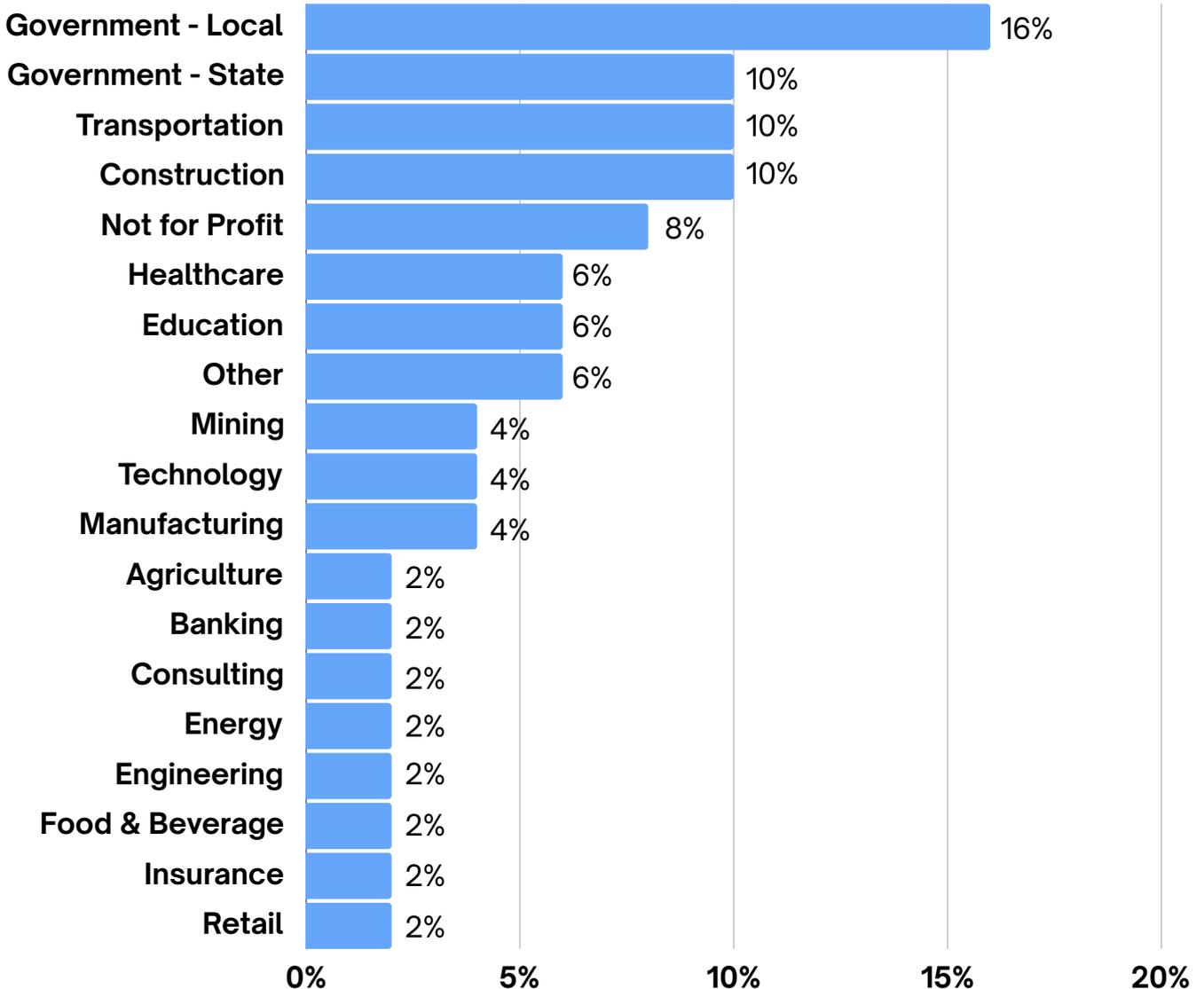

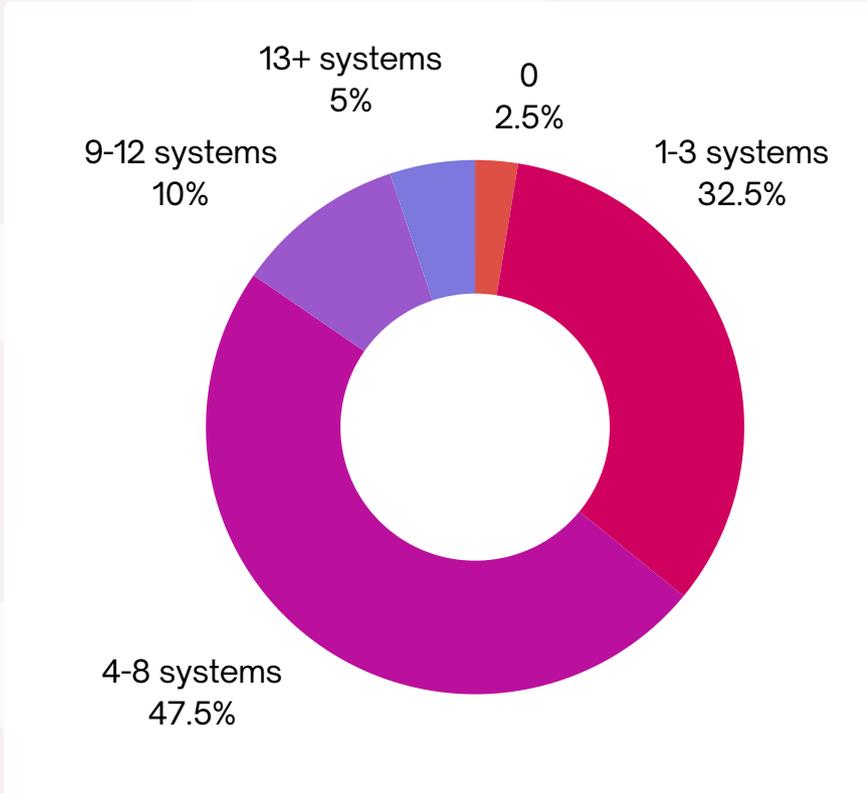

# Technology

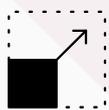
## Number of systems used to manage payroll & HCM



62.5% of respondents are using 4 or more systems to manage payroll and HCM.

This has created a strong need for strict data management processes and integrations.

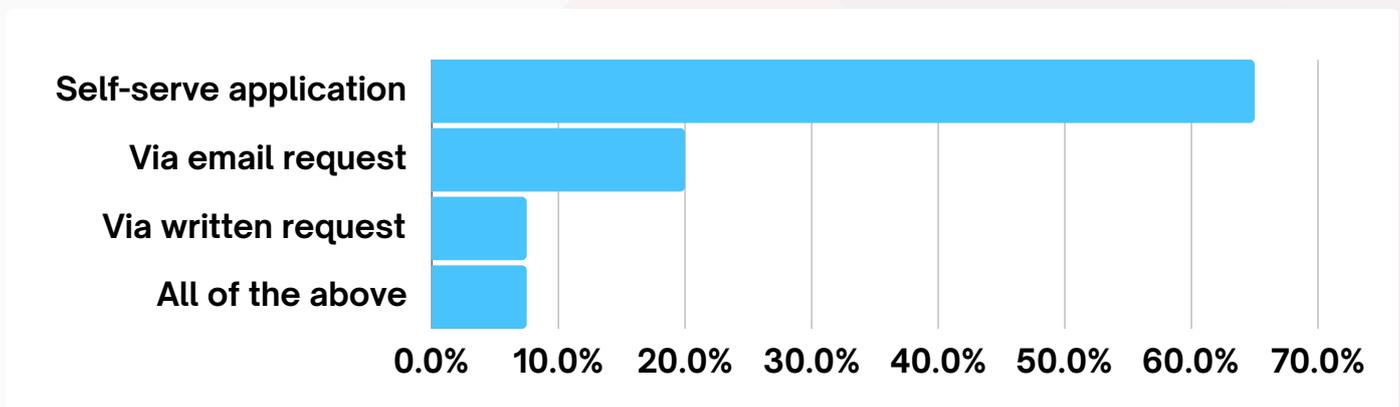
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# Access & Scalability

## How employees access HR-related data

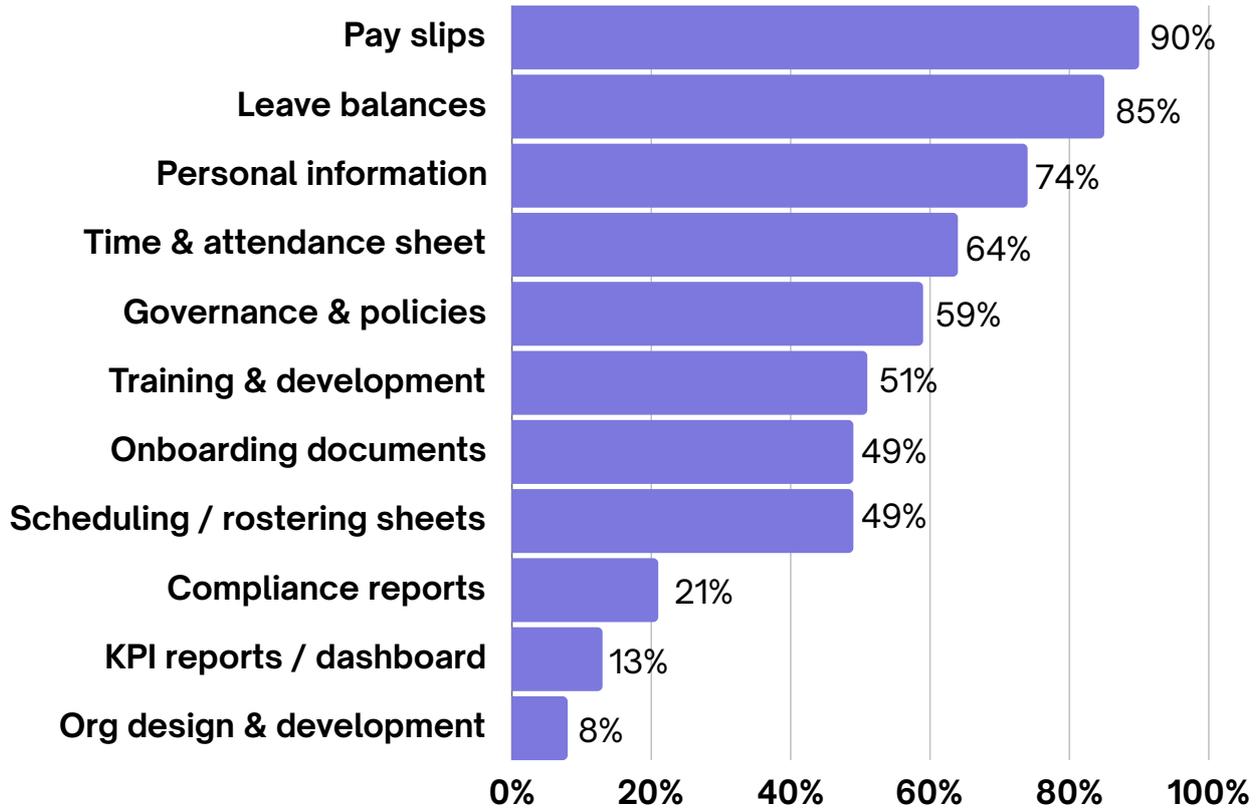
40% of respondents still rely on some form of manual process to access HR data, either through their manager or the HR / payroll team.

# Information

HR information that employees can **CURRENTLY** access without submitting a request



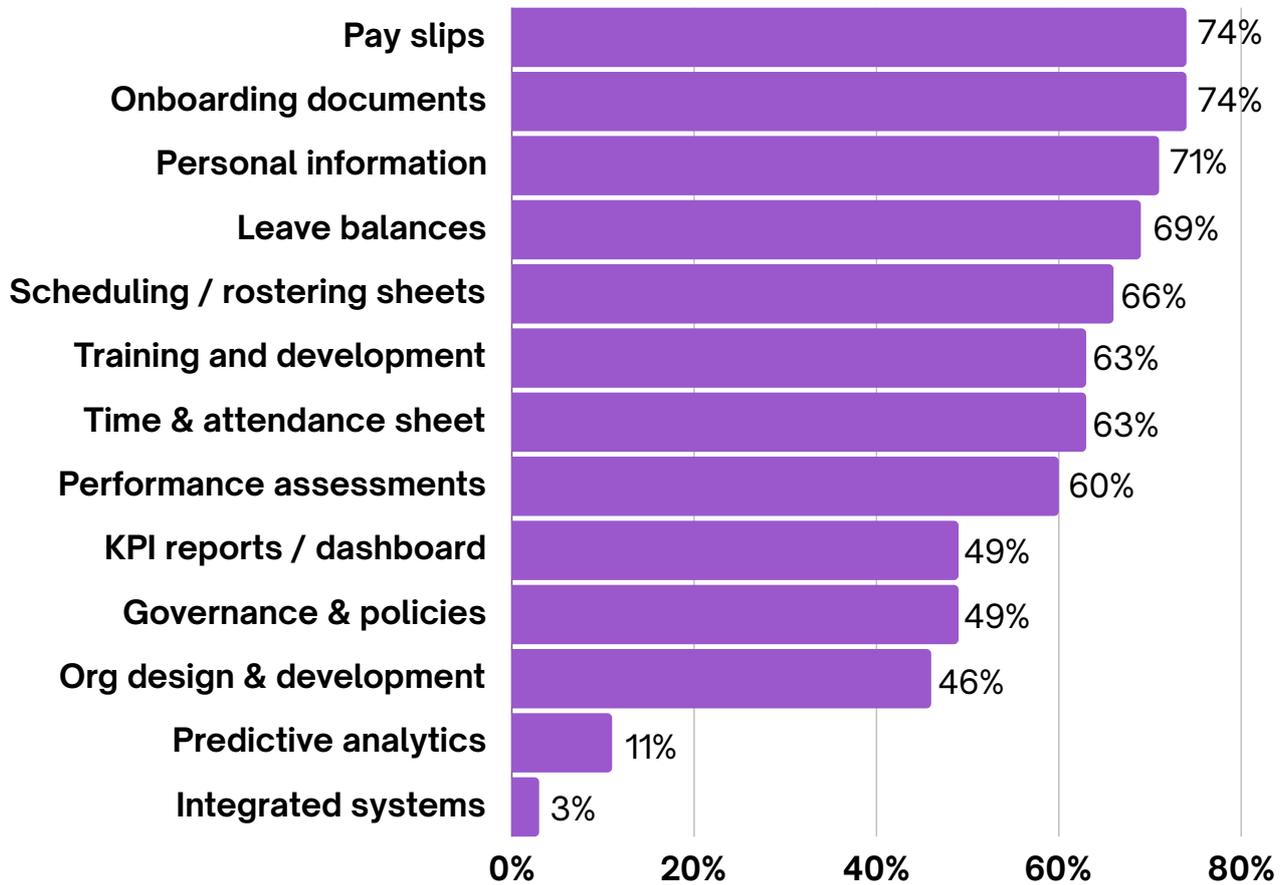

Over 50% of respondents said that their employees still can't access important information themselves including onboarding documentation, rosters, compliance reports, KPI reports and org design data.

It's clear that effective use of reporting and modelling tools in particular is still immature. Only 13% have access to KPI analytics and 21% have access to compliance reports.

Less than 10% of these organisations currently have an org design & development platform, which limits their ability to conduct effective workforce planning.

## HR information that you want your employees to access without submitting a request in FUTURE

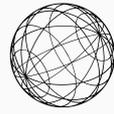


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### The biggest gaps:

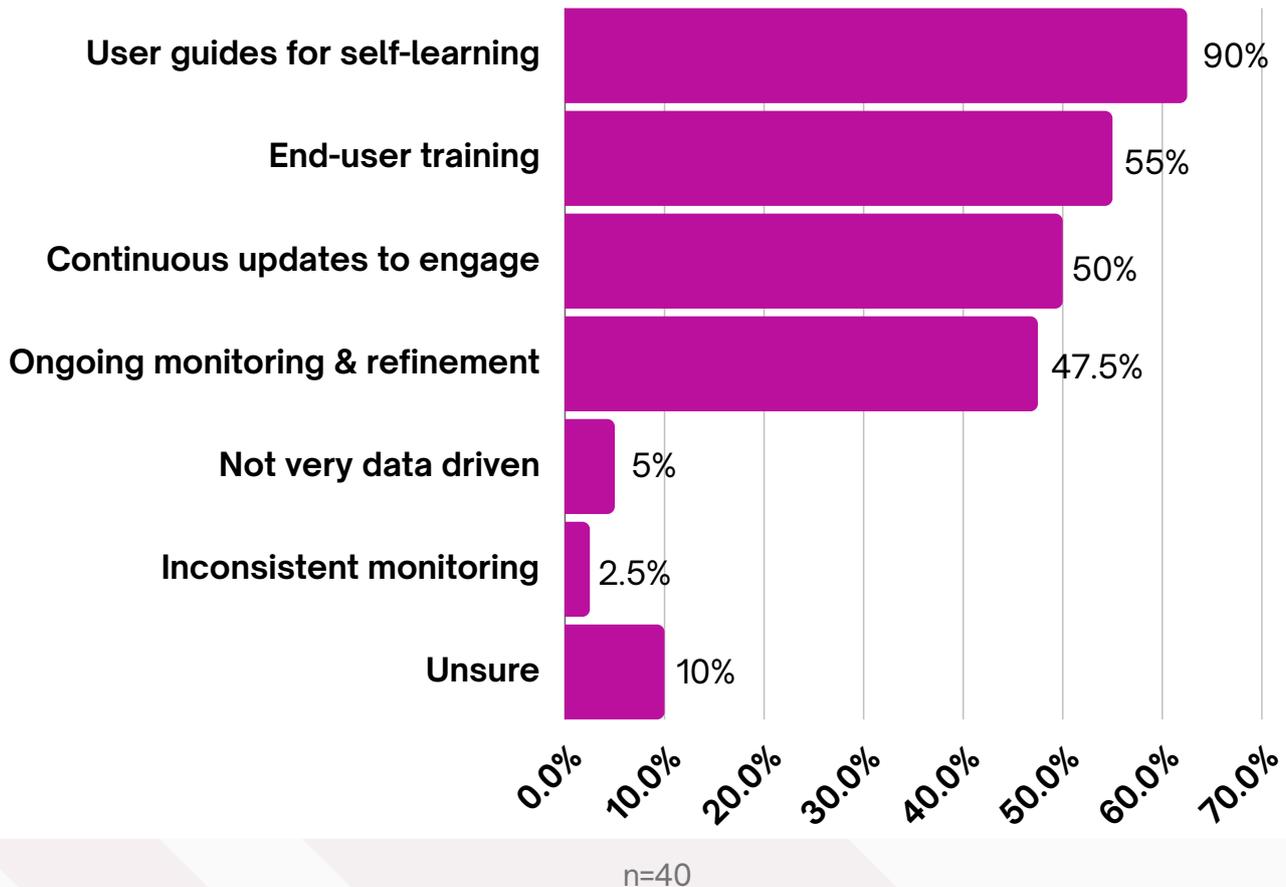
- Only 8% currently have a tool for org design and development, whereas 46% would like to have this in the future.
- 13% of organisations currently have a solution that provides self-serve access to KPIs and benchmark reports / dashboards, when 49% would like to provide this for their organisation in future.
- 21% currently have compliance reports visible to their employees, when 49% would like to provide this for their organisation in future.
- Less than 50% of organisations have onboarding documentation and rosters readily available to their employees, whereas 74% are looking to find a solution to make onboarding documents self-serve and 66% would like a scheduling/rostering solution.

It's clear that there is a strong need for better HR analytics and workforce modelling solutions, as well as dedicated onboarding software.



# Adoption

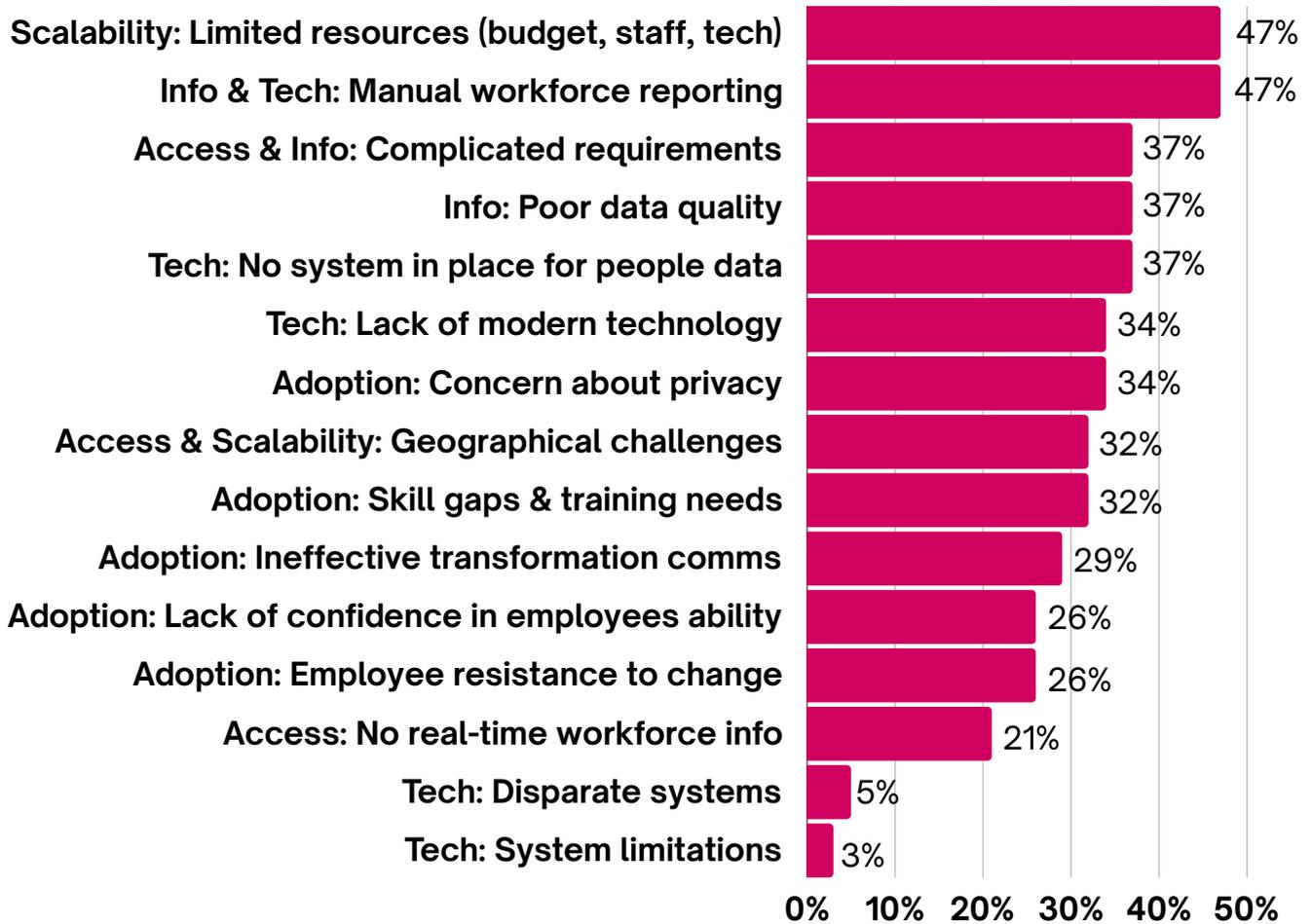
How organisations are increasing use of HR-related data



We've seen that organisations are fairly proactive when it comes to facilitating the effective adoption of HR software. 90% of organisations leverage user guides to educate their employees, followed by 55% who train their end-users directly either themselves or by the vendors.

Only 7.5% of organisations feel that they are not able to use their HR data or don't have the capacity to monitor or nurture engagement.

# The key pain points that impact workforce transformation



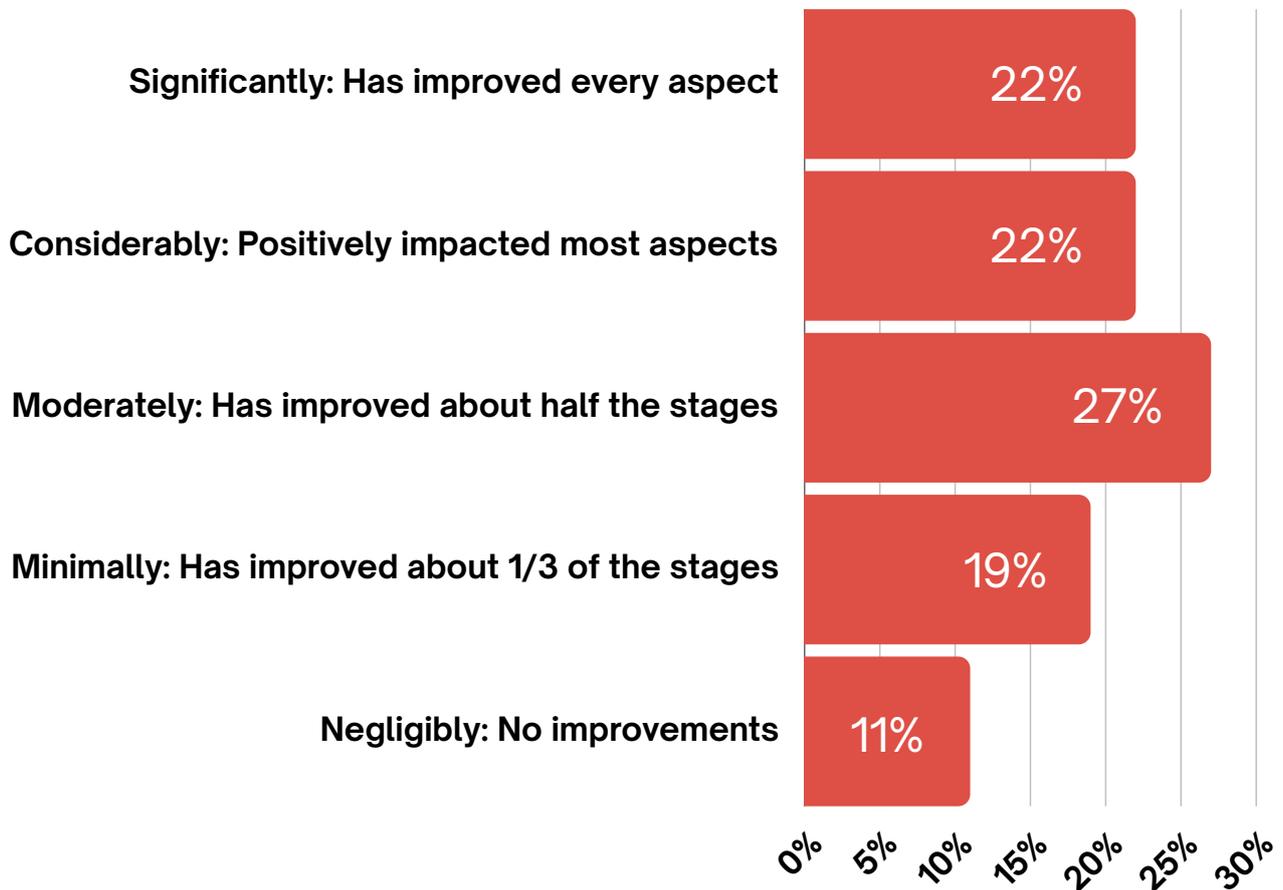

Nearly 50% of all organisations that responded found that their two biggest challenges when it came to workforce transformation were limited resources (budget, staff [specially IT] and tech) and manual workforce reporting.

These two issues definitely affect each other, organisation can only eliminate painful manual reporting if they can establish a strong [business case](#) for tech to get budget and staff allocated.

Two more obstacles that are slowing organisations down is complicated requirements, poor data quality and systems - which affects 37% of all organisations.

# How payroll & HCM technology enhanced employee experience

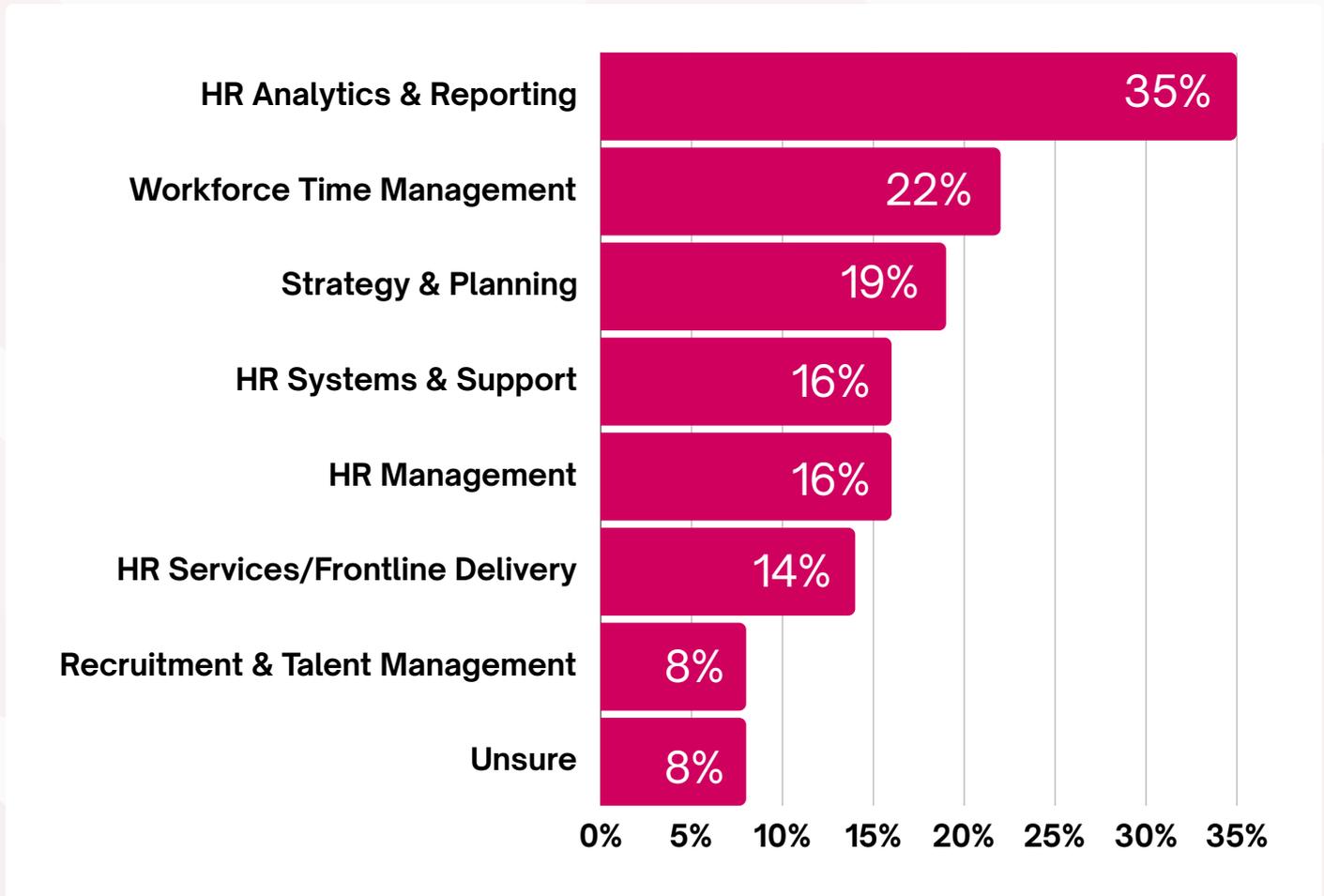

71% of our respondents felt that their application of payroll and HCM technology improved at least half the stages in their employee experience, if not more.

A huge 22% said that the utilisation of payroll and HCM technology has enhanced every aspect of the employee experience.

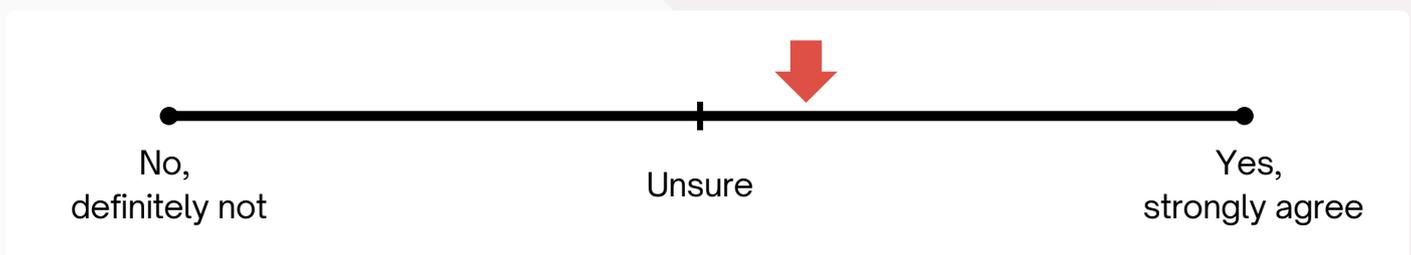
## Tasks that businesses want to prioritise to enhance performance

Not surprising considering the results from the last few charts, but HR Analytics and Reporting was a clear stand out as the #1 area where organisations want to improve.

## Is your HR transformation headed in the right direction?

When we asked respondents whether their HR transformation was headed in the right direction, most fell between unsure and agreeable. 10 of the 33 respondents fell below the unsure mark.
